Please be advised that the Accreditation Commission for Midwifery Education (ACME) Board of Review, the recognized accrediting agency for midwifery and nurse-midwifery education programs, including those programs that offer distance education, convened July 20 and July 27, 2023, and rendered the following actions:

Continued Accreditation

Georgetown University was granted a 10-year continued accreditation for the nurse-midwifery education program, expiring July 31, 2033. (Action Date: 7/20/2023)

Initial Accreditation

Georgia College and State University was granted a 5-year initial accreditation for the nurse-midwifery education program, expiring July 31, 2028. (Action Date: 7/20/2023)

Preaccreditation

George Washington University was granted a 5-year preaccreditation for the nurse-midwifery education program, expiring July 31, 2028. (Action Date: 7/20/2023)

Accreditation Extension

State University of New York (SUNY) Downstate Health Sciences University was granted a 1-year extension for the nurse-midwifery education program, expiring July 31, 2024. (Action Date: 7/20/2023)

Substantive Changes

- The substantive change for the University of New Mexico nurse-midwifery program was approved: changing from a Master's program to DNP.
- The substantive change for Frontier University was approved: 1. removal of courses and 2. elimination of the DNP as an ACME accredited program.
- The substantive change for Shenandoah University was approved: curriculum changes.

Additional Act:

The preaccreditation decision for the proposed new program at Keiser University was deferred for six months.
